Beatriz Cobos Ph.D, is an associate professor of Clinical Psychology at Complutense University of Madrid and a general health psychologist. She has conducted research on the study of psychological interventions for victims of terrorism in Spain.

She wrote her doctoral dissertation on “Very long-term monitoring of the effectiveness of trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy in victims of terrorism in Spain”; she has been working with victims of terrorism developing comprehensive care programs since 2013. Before that, she completed the Comprehensive Assistance to Victims of Terrorism diploma organised by the Spanish Association of Victims of Terrorism (AVT) and UCM. Beatriz now teaches in the Comprehensive Assistance to Victims of Terrorism diploma program.

Having been a member of the IAAP Task Force on Terrorism and Peacebuilding since 2018, she is co-author of more than 10 publications focused on trauma, victims of terrorism or victims of other kinds of violence. She has also coordinated the European Platform for Assisting Victims of Terrorism EPAVT, funded by the European Commission of the European Union. Beatriz has been a member of the Spanish National Network for the assistance of victims of terrorism and since 2012, she also is a member of the International Association of Applied Psychology (IAAP).
