Andrea holds a degree in psychology from the Francisco de Vitoria University in Madrid. She also holds a master's degree in General Health Psychology from the Cardenal Cisneros University (also in Madrid). And she has completed specialized courses in Comprehensive Psychological Assistance of Victims of Terrorism and in Psychological Intervention in Disasters. The Spanish Army Emergency Unit (UME) organized these specialized courses.

In addition, she has specialized in trauma psychology during the past years, when she has been working on her research project, "Psychological treatment of the psychopathological consequences of terrorist attacks and catastrophes" at the Complutense University of Madrid during her predoctoral fellowship there. There, she has conducted psychological assessment and CBT therapy for terrorism victims. This program she is working on is part of a collaboration with the Spanish Association of Victims of Terrorism (AVT). In addition, Andrea has given lectures about victims of terrorism's mental health in several national and international psychology conferences.
