Beatriz Cobos is a Ph.D. candidate at Complutense University of Madrid (UCM). Her research focused on “Very long-term monitoring of the effectiveness of trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy in victims of terrorism in Spain”; she has been working with victims of terrorism developing comprehensive care programs since 2013. Before that, she completed the *Comprehensive Assistance to Victims of Terrorism* diploma organised by the Spanish Association of Victims of Terrorism (AVT) and UCM. Beatriz now teaches in the *Comprehensive Assistance to Victims of Terrorism* diploma program.

Since 2011, Beatriz has been collaborating with the Psychological Clinical Treatment research team at the UCM, coordinating the team (led by María Paz García Vera y Jesús Sanz) with Clara Gestira for several years. The team’s work focuses on comprehensive assistance for victims of terrorism. She has participated in several projects funded with I+D budgets.

She has also coordinated the *European Platform for Assisting Victims of Terrorism-EPAVT*, funded by the European Commission of the European Union. Beatriz has been a member of the Spanish National Network for the assistance of victims of terrorism and since 2012, she also is a member of the International Association of Applied Psychology (IAAP).
