Leonor Pastor is an advanced graduate student, studying to become a clinical psychologist; she currently is completing her graduate work at the Complutense University of Madrid. Starting in her fourth year of studies, she has collaborated with Professor M<sup>a</sup> Paz Garcia-Vera on work for the International Association of Applied Psychology's (IAAP) Task Force on Terrorism and Peace Building, and on work for the Terrorism Victims Association (Asociación de Víctimas del Terrorismo).

For the latter, she completed training on how to conduct phone interviews with victims, then she successfully conducted many victim interviews. She collaborated on the first report on the Task Force on Terrorism of the work carried out in 2018. This work is continuing, and she is still collaborating on the project.

In addition, she has volunteered at events commemorating those tragically lost to 11-M, the 2004 terrorist attacks on Madrid trains. Leonor is currently planning on conducting work in psychosocial rehabilitation, as one of her primary areas of interest is severe mental health disorders, including PTSD and disorders that include psychosis. Leonor also is interested in the area of the psychology of emergencies.
