Between Woxsen University (WoU) and International Association of Applied Psychology (IAAP) Division 15

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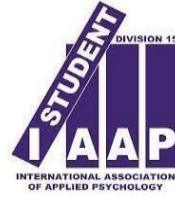
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Section 1: General Information

1.1 About WoU

Woxsen University, located at Kamkole, Sadashivpet, Telangana, India, through its legal representative, Dr. Raul V. Rodrigues, Pro Vice-Chancellor, hereby represents that, Woxsen University is a duly recognized UNIVERSITY by the University Grants Commission and the State of Telangana, under the Telangana Acts and Ordinance No.1, 2020.

WoU has been operational for 7 years, with successfully delivering professionals in Postgraduate Diploma in Management and Post Graduate Diploma for Professionals. With the grant of university status, Woxsen now offers master's in business administration in General management, and Machine learning and Artificial intelligence. Recently, it has introduced the Executive Doctorate in Philosophy, and Bachelor's in Business Administration. We are a



budding institution with the vision of delivering the best trained professionals. We are keen to build an International professional network to keep up with Academics, Industry and events happening Globally. Our vision and mission are to build an institution of excellence in higher learning led through disruption, develop a multi-cultural yet inclusive cohort of global professionals and contribute towards societal welfare. 1.2 About IAAP Division 15

Section 3: Shared Responsibilities


This document outlines the responsibilities that both WoU and IAAP Division 15 agree to have:

- Placement of the other organization's logo on each other's website.
- Promote other organization at the events of their own organization.
- Share responsibility collectively for the common projects and both nominate a specific responsible for a project.
- To include the logo of the counterpart organization in their websites.
- Promotion of the activities and initiatives of the counterpart organization:
 - Through their newsletter.
 - Through their social media profiles.
 - Through their websites.
- There will exist a shared responsibility in the common projects that may be developed. In these cases, both parts will nominate a head-project manager from its organization.

Section 4: Validity of the Collaboration Agreement

This memorandum of understanding is valid until one of the parties decides to change it. Adjustments to this memorandum of understanding can be made at any time, upon approval from both organizations.

This agreement can be terminated by either organization at any time, however, 30 days' notice and a detailed explanation of the reason(s) for this decision must be provided.
