



## 2022 IAAP ELECTIONS

### DIVISION 15

#### **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR PRESIDENT OF DIVISION 15 (STUDENTS)**

In 2022, members of Division 15 (Psychology Students), who are in good standing with IAAP (i.e., 2021 or 2022 membership dues paid, or both), will be asked to elect a new Division President who will assume the presidency of Division 15 at the end of July 2022 for a period of four years.

The Division election will take place in April 2022 if the call for nominations for Division President yields one eligible nomination or more by March 15, 2022. If it does not, then, a second call for nominations for Division President will be launched, and the election will take place between May 15 and June 14, 2022. In either case, the election will be conducted through online voting, using software designed to ensure accurate, secure, closed voting.

The IAAP Student Member who is elected President of Division 15 will serve as Division President from the end of July 2022 until the end of the ICAP to be held in Florence, Italy in July 2026.

#### **Call**

As Chair of the Division Elections Committee for Division 15, I have the pleasure of asking members of Division 15 to submit names of candidates for the office of President of Division 15 in keeping with the *Rules of Procedure for the Election of the IAAP Division 15 President and the Appointment of the Other Division Officers* approved by Board of Directors on June 24, 2018.

#### **Who may be candidate/nominee**

Candidates for Division 15 President must meet two requirements to be eligible for election: (1) they must be IAAP Student Members who have paid their IAAP

membership dues for the year during which the election is held (i.e., 2022) and the year prior to the election (i.e., 2021) and (2) they must have been members of Division 15 during the year preceding the election and the year during which the election takes place.

### **Nomination procedure**

Candidates who wish to run for President of Division 15 are asked to nominate themselves and send a letter to the Chair of the Division Elections Committee, Pedro Altungy ([paltungy@hotmail.es](mailto:paltungy@hotmail.es)) in which they indicate their willingness to serve as President of the Students Division from July 2022 until July 2026.

In addition, they are asked to attach to their letter a short bio/resume (*no more than one page*) in which they highlight their involvement in the Division activities (e.g., newsletter, webinar, contributions to a conference or a research project) and a brief statement (*no more than one page*) in which they state their vision and goals for Division 15.

### **Deadline**

All nominations and supporting documents must be submitted by e-mail directly to the Chair of the Division Elections Committee ([paltungy@hotmail.es](mailto:paltungy@hotmail.es)) with c.c. to the IAAP Secretary-General ([secretarygeneral@iaapsy.org](mailto:secretarygeneral@iaapsy.org)) before 23:59 UTC on 15 March 2022 UTC (Coordinated Universal Time).

### **Voting Procedure**

If there are more than two nominations for the position of President, the Hare Voting System shall be used as the method of voting. Under this system, more commonly referred to as Instant-Runoff Voting or the Plurality with Elimination Method, each voter ranks the candidates in order of preference on a ballot; each ballot counts as exactly one vote for the highest-ranking candidate on that ballot that has not yet been eliminated from the race. If at the end of a count, no candidate has a majority, then the candidate with the fewest number of votes is eliminated, and the vote is recounted. This process continues until some candidate receives a majority. The candidate who receives a majority is declared “elected”.
