



## 2022 ELECTIONS

### Results of the 2022 IAAP President-Elect Election

I am pleased to announce that Prof. Pedro Neves has been elected President-Elect of IAAP for a 4-year term that will start at the end of July 2022 when the current President-Elect, Prof. Lori Foster, assumes the presidency of IAAP.

Out of 680 IAAP Full and Fellow Members eligible to vote, 209 (30.7%) cast their vote. A candidate needed more than half of the votes cast to win (i.e., 106 votes). Prof. Neves received 109 “1” votes after the second-round tally (in accordance with IAAP’s *Rules of Procedure*, voting members were asked to rank nominations in order of preference, and the procedure used for counting ballots was the procedure for preferential voting).

I congratulate Prof. Neves on his election and I thank all the other president-elect candidates who accepted to stand for election, namely (in alphabetical order), Prof. Klaus Boehnke and Prof. Buxin Han.
